Dear Precinct Worker:

This year's Special Election is scheduled for Tuesday, February 23, 2010. As we have been doing since the State of Michigan implemented the new election law, we will be staffing seven (7) precincts with one (1) and five (5) being a combined precinct for this election. Five (5) to Six (6) precinct workers will be scheduled in each precinct. We will not be utilizing the AV Counting Board as there will be ample time during the hours the polls are open to process any absent voter ballots right at the precinct.

If you are interested in working this election, please complete the enclosed application and return it to me **as soon as possible** (no later than January 15, 2010). If you are interested in working, but find that a full-time commitment is not possible, we can split the shift and allow for ½ days. If this is your preference, be sure to note that on the application form. As in the past, inspectors are required to report to their assigned precincts at 6:00 a.m. on Election Day (polls open at 7:00 a.m.). Two 1-hour breaks are given during the day. Polls close at 8:00 p.m. If you prefer a ½ day session, the hours are 6 a.m. – 2 p.m. or 2 p.m. to close.
