**06054.023 Shan-Gri-La Subdivision Proposed Road Improvement Project**  
**Brittany Campbell**, Utilities Coordinator, explained to the residents the details of the project and the purpose of the public hearing.  
  
**Debbie Kooperman** of 9919 Lime Bay Drive asked about combining parcels and if that would affect the amount of the assessment. She also questioned if additional chip seals were included in the final cost given.  
  
**Scott Willets** of 9820 Bluewater Drive questioned the method of financing.  
  
**Rose Stevens** of 4507 Shan-Gri-La questioned the Livingston County Road Commission's legal responsibility for maintaining the roads. She also questioned if the residents would be doing this project again in 7 or 10 years down the road.

**Paul Zahner** of 9510 Bluewater questioned lot combinations to avoid additional assessment charges.

**Lynsey Stevens** of 4507 Shan-Gri-La addressed the Board on her concerns for her parents having to make a choice to pay increased taxes or send her to college. She didn't think that forcing residents to be a part of this S.A.D. was fair.

**Paul Zahner** of 9510 Bluewater let the Board know that the residents were working on getting a single contract for all the trash pickup in the subdivision.

**Rose Stevens** of 4507 Bluewater expressed her concern over the weight limits being more of an issue for Bluewater and the residents of Shan-Gri-La having to bear the cost of it.

8. **Adjournment**


Motion by Hardesty, supported by Hohl to adjourn the meeting.
