Hamburg Township's plan to improve the Trail began with a desire and an idea. Although Hamburg has access to several metro parks, beaches and camping areas, there's nothing "close to home." With that goal in mind, we began the Lakelands Trail Improvement Project.



The project has been funded almost entirely with grant monies from state and private organizations. Actual construction of the Trail began with a groundbreaking ceremony in July, 2006. In November, 2006, the Lakelands Trail Improvement Project was completed.

The “new & improved” Lakelands Trail is a clean, safe, family-friendly environment the whole community can enjoy whether you walk, run, skate or ride. The Trail is handicap-accessible with easy access to the Trail at each trailhead.



We haven't forgotten the horses! Hamburg Township has a large population of riders and in designing the Trail, we worked closely with

several horse riders' associations. The result is a 6' section of turf which runs the entire length of the Trail, adjacent to the asphalt portion. The parking lot at the west trailhead is large enough to accommodate horse trailers.

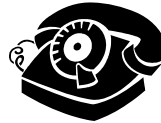
