**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
UPON A PROPOSED ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT
AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT FOR
HILLSIDE LAKES DRIVE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN:

(1) The Township Board of Hamburg Township, Livingston County, Michigan, in accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan, will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, July 21, 2020 at 6:30 p.m., at the Hamburg Township Hall, 10405 Merrill Road, Hamburg, Michigan 48139, to review the following proposed special assessment district:

**HAMBURG TOWNSHIP HILLSIDE LAKES DRIVE
ROAD IMPROVEMENT SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT**

and to hear any objections thereto and to the proposed Project and to the petitions filed with the Township Board requesting the Project.

(2) The project (the "Project") will include repaving the existing asphalt on approximately 154,000 square feet of the following roads; Foxgate Court and Hillside Lakes Drive located in Green Oak Charter Township and including the 42,000 square foot portion of Hillside Lakes Drive located within Hamburg Township. The Contractor shall mill and remove the existing asphalt pavement, re-grade and compact the base and then place four-inches (4") of new hot mix asphalt (HMA) pavement in two lifts. Contractor shall be responsible to clean up all debris from the paving operations. The Project is being designed to serve the properties in the Special Assessment District, which properties are adjacent to Hillside Lakes Drive, and which properties are identified by the following permanent parcel numbers:

(3) The Township plans on imposing special assessments on the properties located in the Special Assessment District to pay for the costs of the Project.

(4) The plans and cost estimates for the proposed Project, the boundaries of the Special Assessment District and the petitions filed in support of the Project are now on file in the office of the Township Clerk for public inspection. Periodic redeterminations of the cost of the Project may be made, and subsequent hearings shall not be required if such cost redeterminations do not increase the estimated cost of the Project by more than 10%. Any person objecting to the proposed Project, the petitions for the Project or the proposed Special Assessment District shall file an objection in writing with the Township Clerk before the close of the July 21st, 2020, hearing or within such further time the Township Board may grant.

This notice is given by order of the Hamburg Township Board.
